Council Tax – Second Home Questionnaire

A Council Taxpayer may be entitled to 50% discount in the Council Tax for a second home if they are liable to pay Council Tax on the second home as well as their main home and either of those properties is job related.

A dwelling is job-related for a person if it is provided by reason of his employment, in any of the following cases -(a) Where it is necessary for the proper performance of the duties of the employment that the employee should reside in that dwelling.

(b) Where the dwelling is provided for the better performance of the duties of the employment, and it is one of the kinds of employment in the case of which it is customary for employers to provide dwellings to employees.(c) Where, there being a special threat to the employee's security, special security arrangements are in force and the employee resides in the dwelling as part of those arrangements.

Whilst it may often be convenient for a person to live local to their work, the property must be provided by an employer under a contract of employment and they must be required to live in that particular property in order to qualify for the 50% discount.

If you wish to apply for a job related second home discount please complete this application form and return it to Bedford Borough Council. In order for consideration to be given to your application you will need to provide evidence, such as your contract of employment, that your employer requires you to live in the particular property in order to better perform your duties.
