(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

Notice is hereby given that the Order made by Bedford Borough Council on the 21st May 2021, extended on 19th November 2021, 20th May 2022 and 19th of May 2023 the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along the length of Footpath No 7, Ravensden which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0611 5360 (Map point A) to (OS GR) TL 0579 5451 (Map point B) has been continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 30th May 2024.

This temporary closure is required to carry out highway roundabout works.

The closure will continue from Tuesday 30th May 2023 for a period of up to one year.

The alternative route for footpath users choosing to stay on the right of way network is to proceed south west along Footpath No 52, then northerly along Footpath No 6 and then Footpath No 48 to the junction with Bridleway No 54, proceed south easterly to site and vice versa.

The Order will come into operation on 30th May 2023 for a period not exceeding one year or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to the footpath have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within one year the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
