

PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE A NEW ZEBRA CROSSING AND PARKING RESTRICTION CHANGES ON NEWNHAM ROAD, BEDFORD

Reason for Proposal:

Under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) Bedford Borough Council propose to establish a new zebra crossing in Newnham Road, Bedford. The proposal is intended to improve pedestrian safety in Newnham Road, as a zebra crossing will provide an identified, controlled crossing point for pedestrians.

To facilitate the carriageway lining associated with the new zebra crossing, it will be necessary to revoke some double yellow lines and a section of single yellow line. The double and single yellow lines will be replaced by the requisite zebra crossing zig-zag lines.

Effect of the Proposals:

1. To establish a new zebra crossing at the following location:-

Α	Newnham Road, Bedford	
(i)	The centre of the zebra crossing is approx. 7 metres south of the southern	
	side of Castle Road.	

2. To revoke double yellow lines on the following length of road:-

Α	Newnham Road, Bedford
(i)	On its eastern kerb, extending from the southern side of Castle Road for a
	distance of approx. 14 metres in a southerly direction.
(ii)	On its western kerb, extending from the southern side of Castle Road for a
	distance of approx. 32.5 metres in a southerly direction.

3. To revoke a single yellow line on the following length of road:

Α	Newnham Road, Bedford
(i)	On its eastern kerb, extending from a point approx. 14 metres south of the
	southern side of Castle Road for a distance of approx. 15 metres in a
	southerly direction.

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL ("the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended ("the Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as the "Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Controlled Parking Zone) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2017 (Amendment No.20) Order 2023" and shall come into force on 2nd October 2023.
- 2. As from the date upon which this Order comes into force the provisions of the Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Controlled Parking Zone) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2017 as amended shall be varied as follows:
 - (i) The plan schedule reference "Grid Ref: K 27 Revision No: 5" shall be deleted and the plan schedule reference "Grid Ref: K 27 Revision No: 6" shall be inserted.
- This Amendment shall be read and construed as one with the Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Controlled Parking Zone) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2017 as amended.



STATEMENT OF REASONS


