

PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO AMEND SOME PARKING RESTRICTIONS AND ESTABLISH A NEW PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE CROSSING IN MANTON LANE, BEDFORD

Reason for Proposal:

Bedford Borough Council has received a request to amend some parking restrictions in Manton Lane, Bedford. A new school entrance is being constructed at this location, so the parking restriction changes are deemed necessary to facilitate the new entrance and to help maintain safety for both those attending the school and other highway users in the area.

Also, under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) Bedford Borough Council propose to establish a new parallel pedestrian and cycle crossing on Manton Lane, Bedford. The proposal is intended to improve pedestrian and cyclist safety in Manton Lane, as the crossing will provide an identified, controlled crossing point.

Effect of the Order:

1. To revoke "No waiting at any time" restrictions (double yellow lines) on the following lengths of road:

Α	Manton Lane, Bedford
(i)	On its western kerb, extending from a point approx. 9.2 metres north of the
	projected centre of Murdock Road for a distance of approx. 124.4 metres in a
	northerly direction.
(ii)	On its eastern kerb, extending from a point approx. 43.5 metres north of the
	centre of Murdock Road for a distance of approx. 10.3 metres in a northerly
	direction.

2. To introduce "No stopping on entrance markings" restrictions on the following lengths of road:

Α	Manton Lane, Bedford
(i)	On its western kerb, extending from a point approx. 9.2 metres north of the
	projected centre of Murdock Road for a distance of approx. 25.6 metres in a
	northerly direction.
(ii)	On its western kerb, extending from a point approx. 90.2 metres north of the
	projected centre of Murdock Road for a distance of approx. 43.4 metres in a
	northerly direction.

3. To establish a new parallel pedestrian and cycle crossing at the following location:

Α	Manton Lane, Bedford		
(i)	Between a point approx. 43.5 metres north of the centre of Murdock Road		

and a point approx. 90.2 metres north of the centre of Murdock Road, the centre of the crossing being approx. 66.85 metres north of the centre of Murdock Road.

4. To introduce a "No waiting at any time" restriction (double yellow lines) on the following length of road:

Α	Manton Lane, Bedford
(i)	On its eastern kerb, extending from a point approx. 90.2 metres north of the
	centre of Murdock Road for a distance of approx. 40.35 metres in a northerly
	direction.

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL ("the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as the "Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Urban Area (North of the River Excluding Queens Park and CPZ Areas)) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2009 (Amendment No.90) Order 2023" and shall come into force on 6th November 2023.
- 2. As from the date upon which this Order comes into force the provisions of the Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Urban Area (North of the River Excluding Queens Park and CPZ Areas)) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2009 as amended shall be varied as follows:
 - (i) The plan schedule reference "Grid Ref: I 19 Revision No: 3" shall be deleted and the plan schedule reference "Grid Ref: I 19 Revision No: 4" shall be inserted.
 - (ii) The plan schedule reference "Grid Ref: I 20 Revision No: 4" shall be deleted and the plan schedule reference "Grid Ref: I 20 Revision No: 5" shall be inserted.

3. This Amendment shall be read and construed as one with the Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Urban Area (North of the River Excluding Queens Park and CPZ Areas)) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2009 as amended.







