## Wootton Neighbourhood Development Plan

On 11<sup>th</sup> February 2015 Wootton Parish Council resolved to apply to Bedford Borough Council to designate Wootton as a Neighbourhood Area. Minutes dated 11<sup>th</sup> February 2015, reference FC15/39, as enclosed.

Pursuant to this resolution and sections 61F and 61G of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (the Act) and regulation 5 of Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (the Regulations), we hereby formally apply to Bedford Borough Council for the designation of the whole of this parish as a Neighbourhood Area. Please find enclosed a map showing the area of the Parish of Wootton applied for, outlined in red.

In accordance with regulation 5(b) we assert that it is desirable that the whole of Wootton be designated as a Neighbourhood Area so that a more integrated approach to planning at the neighbourhood level can be achieved.

In accordance with regulation 5(c) we assert that Wootton Parish Council is the relevant body for the purposes of S61G of the Act.

Having regard to *inter alia* S61G (3) (a) of the Act we believe the area applied for has not already been designated as a Neighbourhood Area and that the areas applied for by Wootton and neighbouring parishes do not overlap.

We look forward to receiving your formal approval of this application in due course and to working with the Borough Council to shape the future of Wootton.


