

## PUBLIC NOTICE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 23

## BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO ESTABLISH A TOUCAN CROSSING ON CLAPHAM ROAD, BEDFORD

<u>Reason for Proposal:</u> Bedford Borough Council intends to re-locate a signalled crossing on Clapham Road, Bedford to centralise a pedestrian crossing point, improve location for school users, and allow better vehicular movements into side roads.

<u>The Location of the Proposed Toucan Crossing</u> is on Clapham Road, Bedford. The centre of the crossing will be outside no. 36, approximately 75.5 metres north-west of the centre of Slade Walk, Bedford.

<u>Further Details</u> of the proposed toucan crossing, a plan and a statement of reasons for proposing to establish the crossing may be examined during normal working hours at Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford. These documents are also available on the <u>www.bedford.gov.uk/tro</u> website. The details will be placed on deposit until 6 weeks after the crossings are commissioned or until it is decided not to continue with the proposal.
