## BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO INTRODUCE A PROHIBITION OF U TURNS ON GOLDINGTON ROAD, BEDFORD

#### Reason for Proposal:

Goldington Road, Bedford is a very busy dual carriageway. The dual carriageway is divided at its junction with Perkins Road, which itself is a busy road. It is a traffic light controlled junction, incorporating a controlled pedestrian crossing.

To improve road safety, it is felt that a Prohibition of U Turns is necessary at this junction to prevent vehicles turning into the busy stream of oncoming traffic and across traffic entering Goldington Road from Perkins Road.

#### **Effect of the Order:**

1. To introduce a Prohibition of U Turns on Goldington Road, Bedford, at its junction with Perkins Road, to prevent northeast-bound vehicles turning across southwest-bound vehicles.

# BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (GOLDINGTON ROAD, BEDFORD) (PROHIBITION OF U TURNS) ORDER 2024

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("The Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- No person shall, except upon the direction or with permission of a Police Constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to make a U turn in Goldington Road at its junction with Perkins Road.
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire brigade or Special Forces purposes in the event of an emergency.
- 3. This Order shall come into operation on 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2024 and may be cited as the "Bedford Borough Council (Goldington Road, Bedford) (Prohibition of U Turns) Order 2024".
