

PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO INTRODUCE 'NO WAITING AT ANYTIME' RESTRICTIONS ON VARIOUS ROADS WITHIN GREAT BARFORD

Reason for Proposal: At the request of Great Barford Parish Council, Bedford Borough Council proposes to introduce 'no waiting at anytime' (double yellow lines) parking restrictions on various roads within Great Barford. The proposals are aimed to improve the movement of traffic and improve visibility at road junctions.

Effect of Order:

1. To introduce 'no waiting at anytime' restrictions on the following road

A – Silver Street

- (i) On its most eastern kerb, extending the existing double yellow lines by a distance of approximately 2.5 metres in a north easterly direction from its junction with The Spencers
- (ii) On its most northern kerb, extending from its junction with Pym's Close for a distance approximately 29 metres in an eastern direction and 14.5 metres in a western direction
- (iii) On its most southern kerb, a length approximately 5 metres outside property no's 57 & 59 Silver Street

B – The Spencers

- (i) On its most southern kerb, between the driveways serving property no's 1 & 3 The Spencers and on its most northern kerb between the driveways serving property no.3 Silver Street and property no.4 The Spencers

C – Brook Lane

- (i) The entire turning head located outside property no's 39 & 41 Brook Lane

Bedford Borough Council (“the Council”) in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“The Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Bedfordshire Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on * day of * 2017 and may be cited as “Bedford Borough Council (Parish of Great Barford, Bedford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Stopping and Parking Places) Order 2015 (Amendment No.1) Order 2017
2. As from the date upon which this Order comes into operation, the provision of the “Bedford Borough Council (Parish of Great Barford, Bedford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Stopping and Parking Places) Order 2015 shall be varied as follows:
 - (i) The plan schedule reference “Grid Reference F7 Revision No 0” shall be deleted and “Grid Reference F7 Revision No 1” shall be substituted
 - (ii) The plan schedule reference “Grid Reference G6 Revision No 0” shall be deleted and “Grid Reference G6 Revision No 1” shall be substituted
 - (iii) The plan schedule reference “Grid Reference G7 Revision No 0” shall be deleted and “Grid Reference G7 Revision No 1” shall be substituted

Bedford Borough Council has received a request from Great Barford Parish Council to consider installing additional yellow lines in the village.

Silver Street and Pym's Close

To address inconsiderate parking at the road junction, and to provide clearance on a short section of road to enable pedestrians to cross and access the schools.

The Spencers

To prevent inconsiderate parking and ensure access along the road can be maintained at all times

Brook Lane

To keep the turning head clear of parked vehicles
