5. Stakeholder Engagement EWR/BBC - Ashburnham Road and impact to Nos. 2 - 20 ARC updated the group on the creation of a BBC engagement ARC to circulate finalised engagement plan. Discussion regarding next steps for resident and plan. business engagement, to involve a door-knocking exercise of properties affected on Ashburnham Road. AR to confirm details of domestic households within 2-20 evens Ashburnham Road. ARC to organise door-knocking exercise of properties affected on 2 - 20 evens Ashburnham Road. AR to provide support with outreach activities. Meeting to be rescheduled with the Mayor and Portfolio JBB to liaise with Mayor's Office to Holders for Environment & Planning to discuss plan for rearrange meeting. CA, JBB, ARC, PP, JM engaging with impacted residents, businesses and landlords and DS to attend in 2 – 20 evens on Ashburnham Road and seek their steer on next steps. 6. Planning Infrastructure Bill (PIB) DS advised that more information about the Planning GC to share CPO powers and purchase Infrastructure Bill is expected to be released in November. guidance already available. Expected implications are a reduction of the Notice period given to properties at risk of a CPO in certain circumstances. Discussion regarding a need for the Council to understand the legal grounds enabling the use of a CPO for 2-20DS to look into suitable external legal Ashburnham Road as only option. support JBB expressed frustration and confirmed that she has again followed up with EWR regarding the technical note they have promised, justifying the requirement to demolish 2 - 20 evens on Ashburnham Road. 7. **EWR Licences for access to BBC land & property** JBB and DS confirmed that licences have been prepared for JBB to prepare a briefing note for the EWR to gain access to 108 Council-owned sites within the Mayor outlining licence agreements and red line. DS has sent EWR amendments where gaps in these implications before these are signed. licences have been identified.
