The above Order made on 10th March 2014, if confirmed as made will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by:-
adding to them the footpath from Ashburnham Road to The Avenue, via Guru Ravidass Lane, Bedford.

Footpath No. E46 Bedford to be added extends from its junction with the Ashburnham Road at Ordnance Survey grid Reference [OS GR] SP 0416 4995 (Order Map - point A) in a generally east north easterly direction for 97 metres to OS GR SP 0425 4998 (Order Map - point B) where it has a junction with The Avenue.

A copy of the Order and the map may be seen free of charge at the offices of Bedford Borough Council, Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford, or Customer Service Centre, Horne Lane, Bedford during normal office hours. Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to the GIS and Orders Officer, Highways and Transport, Room 436, Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford MK42 9AP not later than 25th April 2014. Please state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Bedford Borough Council may, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State in whole or in part, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
