(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

Notice is hereby given that the Order made by Bedford Borough Council made on 15th December 2022, extended on 1st September 2023 the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along the length of Wyboston Chawston and Colesden: Footpath No 7 which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 1562 5543 (Map point A) to OS GR TL1559 5614 (Map point B) has been continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 2nd July 2025.

This temporary closure is required to facilitate works associated with the Improvement Scheme for the A428 Black Cat to Caxton Gibbett.

The closure is to continue from Wednesday 3rd July 2024 for up to one year.

There is no alternative route for users while the closure is in operation.

The Order will come into operation on 3rd July 2024 for a period not exceeding one year or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to the footpath have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within one year the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
