## (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

Notice is hereby given that the Order made by Bedford Borough Council on the 15<sup>th</sup> December 2022, extended on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2023 and the 21<sup>st</sup> June 2024 the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along the length of part of public footpath No A10 and footpath No 10 Wyboston, Chawston, and Colesden which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 1537 5536 to OS GR TL 1475 5572 has been continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 2nd July 2026.

This closure is required to facilitate works associated with the Improvement Scheme for the A428 Black Cat to Caxton Gibbett.

## The closure is to continue from Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2025 for up to one year.

There is no alternative route for footpath users while the closure is in operation.

The Order will come into operation on 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2025 for a period not exceeding one year or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to the footpaths have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within one year the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
