(GREAT DENHAM: PART OF FOOTPATH NO 1)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

Notice is hereby given that the Order made by Bedford Borough Council on 28th March 2024, extended on 24th September 2024 the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along part of the length of public Footpath No 1 Great Denham which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0195 4898 (Map point A) to OS GR TL 0202 4880 (Map point B) has been continued in force with the approval of the Secretary for Transport until 3rd October 2026.

This temporary closure is required for the construction of a new housing development.

The closure will continue from Saturday 4th October 2025 for a period of one year.

The alternative route for footpath users while the closure is in operation will be to cross over to the adjacent footpath.

The Order will come into operation on 4th October 2025 for a period not exceeding one year until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to the footpath have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within one year the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
