(STEWARTBY: FOOTPATH NO 5)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

Notice is hereby given that the order made by Bedford Borough Council on 6th September 2004, extended 7th March 2025 the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along the length of Stewartby: Footpath No 5 which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0147 4305 (Map point A) to OS GR TL 0186 4242 (Map point B) has been continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 15th March 2027.

This closure is required to carry out demolition works. The closure will continue from Monday 16th March 2026 for up to a year.

There is no alternative route for footpath users while the closure is in operation.

The Order will come into operation on 16th March 2026 for a period not exceeding one year or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to the footpath have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within one year the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
