VARIOUS PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY NEAR TO CLEAT HILL, BEDFORD

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

Notice is hereby given that the Bedford Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit All users from proceeding along the following lengths of paths for a period of six months:

Ravensden Footpath No 25 - from Cleat Hill to Oldways Road

Ravensden Footpath No 26 – from Cleat Hill to Bedford Road, Ravensden

Ravensden Part of Footpath No 52 – from Bedford Road, Ravensden to OSGR TL 0583 5328

Ravensden Footway No 58 – from Cleat Hill

Ravensden Part of Bridleway No 23 – from Kimbolton Road to its junction with Footpath No 19 at OSGR TL 0581 5323

Douglas Road Footway Link joining Bridleway No 23

Rhineland Way Footway Link joining Bridleway No 23

extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) (Map point A) to OS GR (Map point B).

This temporary closure is required due to an ongoing emergency incident. The Public rights of Way are closed and people are being asked to avoid the area and to find alternative routes. This closure follows an emergency made on 23rd October 2024 and will continue from 14th November 2024 for up to six months.

There is no alternative route for users while the closure is in operation.

The Order will come into operation on 14th November 2024 for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to the paths have been completed, whichever is the earlier.

If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
