

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

(STEVINGTON: FOOTPATH NO 16 AND PAVENHAM: FOOTPATH NOS A1 AND 15)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

Notice is hereby given that the Bedford Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot along the length of Stevington: Footpath No 16 and Pavenham: Footpath Nos A1 and 15 which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 9857 5520 (Map point A) to Ordnance Survey Grid Reference TL 9833 5418 (Map point B).

This closure is required due to surface condition. The closure follows an emergency made on the 4th December 2024 and will continue from 26th December 2024 for up to six months.

There is no alternative route for users while the closure is in operation.

The Order will come into operation on 26th December 2024 for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to the footpaths have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
