

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)

(BOLNHURST KEYSOE BRIDLEWAY NO 59 AND COLMWORTH BRIDLEWAY NO 3)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

Notice is hereby given that the Bedford Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot or on horseback or lead a horse or cycle along the length of Bolnhurst Keysoe: Bridleway No 59 and Colmworth: Bridleway No 3 which extends from. Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0946 5924 (Map point A) to OS GR TL 1074 5902 (Map point B).

This closure is required as the bridge is unsafe. The closure follows an emergency made on the 5th March 2025 and will continue from Thursday 27th March 2025 up to six months.

There is no alternative route for users while the closure is in operation.

The Order will come into operation on 27th March 2025 for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to the bridleways have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
