Bedford Borough Council proposes to Introduce a new “No Waiting Restriction” In Beatrice Street, Kempston

Reason for Proposals:

The purpose of the order is to help maintain visibility and safety at this location.

Effect of the Order:

1. To introduce a “No waiting at any time” restriction on the following length of road:

A	Beatrice Street, Kempston
(i)	On the southern side, from the boundary line of No 70 Beatrice Street extending for a distance of 30 metres in a south-east direction
