ORDER 2026

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (“the Council”) in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (“the Act”) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

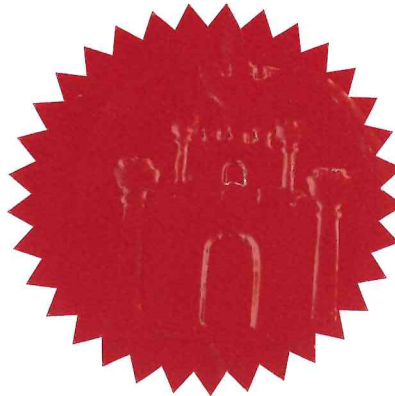
1. This Order may be cited as the “Bedford Borough Council (Broadmead Road, Stewartby- Clearway) Order 2026” and shall come into force on 1st June 2026.
2. Except where otherwise stated and referenced in this Order a number or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
3. Save as provided in Articles 4 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to stop on the lengths of road specified in the schedule to this order at any time(24 hour clearway restriction).
4. (i) Nothing in Article 3 of this order shall apply to:
 - (a) the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road so referred to or in the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said lengths of road of any sewer or main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as described in the Telegraph Act 1878; or
 - (b) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance, police or special forces purposes; or
 - (c) the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road to be used of a Local Authority in pursuance of Statutory Powers or duties; or
 - (d) the person in control of the vehicle if required by law to stop, or if obliged to do so in order to avoid an accident, or if prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond their control.
5. As from the date upon which this Order comes into force any previous Order made under the Act which relates to waiting in any length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall be revoked in whole or in part as appropriate.

A	Broadmead Road, Stewartby
(i)	Starting from a point 25.1 metres south east of the junction with the A421 Woburn Road and extending in a south easterly direction to a point 20 metres north of the projected centre line of the Broadmead Road and Kiln Drive roundabout.
