

PUBLIC NOTICE

Bedford Borough Council proposes to introduce a 24-hour clearway on Broadmead Road, Stewartby

Reason for Proposal:

To prevent dangerous parking, facilitate the free flow of traffic and prevent obstruction of the highway along Broadmead Road. This is required for the completion of enabling works and will be in place permanently when the development is complete.

Effect of the Order:

1. **To introduce a 24- hour clearway in the following location:**

| A | Broadmead Road, Stewartby |

| (i) | Starting from a point 25.1 metres south east of the junction with the A421 Woburn Road and extending in a south easterly direction to a point 20 metres north of the projected centre line of the Broadmead Road and Kiln Drive roundabout. |
