

PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO INTRODUCE A 5 TONNE WAITING RESTRICTION ON BRUNEL ROAD, BEDFORD

Reason for Proposal:

Bedford Borough Council have received complaints about HGVs being left parked for long periods in Brunel Road, causing difficulties for other vehicles requiring access to the commercial and industrial premises in Brunel Road.

Therefore, this proposed waiting restriction is deemed necessary to remedy this.

Effect of the Order:

1. To introduce a 5 tonne waiting restriction between the hours of 6:00am and 4:00pm Monday – Friday, on the following length of road:

Α	Brunel Road, Bedford	
(i)	On its northern kerb, from a point approx. 33 metres west of its junction v	
	Barker's Lane extending for a distance of approx. 202.5 metres in a westerly	
	direction to the start of the existing 'No waiting at any time' restriction.	
(ii)	On its southern kerb, extending from its junction with Barker's Lane for a	
	distance of approx. 252 metres in a westerly direction to the start of the exiting	
	'No waiting at any time' restriction.	
(iii)	On its western kerb, extending from the southern side of its northern leg for a	
	distance of approx. 52 metres in a southerly direction to the start of the exiting	
	'No waiting at any time' restriction.	
(iv)	On its eastern kerb, extending from the southern side of its northern leg for a	
	distance of approx. 55 metres in a southerly direction to the start of the exiting	
	'No waiting at any time' restriction.

The documents will be placed on deposit until 6 weeks after the Order is made or until it is decided not to continue with the proposal. BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL ("the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as the "Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Urban Area (North of the River Excluding Queens Park and CPZ Areas)) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2009 (Amendment No.110) Order 2024" and shall come into force on 16th December 2024.
- 2. As from the date upon which this Order comes into force the provisions of the Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Urban Area (North of the River Excluding Queens Park and CPZ Areas)) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2009 as amended shall be varied as follows:
 - (i) The plan schedule reference "Grid Ref: O 28 Revision No: 2" shall be deleted and the plan schedule reference "Grid Ref: O 28 Revision No: 3" shall be inserted.
- 3. This Amendment shall be read and construed as one with the Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Urban Area (North of the River Excluding Queens Park and CPZ Areas)) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2009 as amended.


