

PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO INTRODUCE SOME PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN WILKINSON ROAD AND OTHER ROADS, KEMPSTON

Reason for Proposal:

As part of planning requirements and a request from Ward Councillors, Bedford Borough Council proposes to introduce some parking restrictions in various roads in Kempston.

Effect of the Order:

1. To introduce 'No waiting at any time' restrictions (double yellow lines) on the following lengths of roads:

Α	Wilkinson Road, Kempston
(i)	On its west kerb, extending from a point approx. 25.0 metres north of the
	north side of Griffin Way for a distance of approx. 28.0 metres in a northerly
В	direction. Crowsley Road, Kempston
(i)	On both sides of the road, extending from its junction with Martell Drive for a
(1)	distance of approx. 12.5 metres in an easterly direction.
(ii)	On its north-west kerb, extending from the projected north-east flank wall of no. 16 Crowsley Road for a distance of approx. 15 metres in a southerly direction.
(iii)	On its south-west kerb, extending from the centre of Henman Close for a distance of approx. 10.5 metres in north-westerly direction, and for a distance of approx. 15 metres in an easterly direction.
(iv)	On its north-east kerb, extending from a point approx. 10.5 metres north-west of the centre of Henman Close for a distance of approx. 23 metres in an easterly direction.
С	Henman Close, Kempston
(i)	On both sides of the road, extending from its junction with Crowsley Road for
	a distance of approx. 10 metres in a south-westerly direction.
(ii)	On both sides of the road, extending from the centre of Chibnall Close for a
	distance of approx. 10 metres in both a north-easterly and south-westerly
	direction.
D	Chibnall Close, Kempston
(i)	On both sides of the road, extending from its junction with Henman Close for
	a distance of approx. 10 metres in a south-easterly direction.
(ii)	On its south-eastern kerb (at its south-eastern end) and extending on both its
	north-eastern and south-western kerbs for a distance of approx. 1 metre in a
_	north-westerly direction.
E	Martell Drive, Kempston
(i)	On both sides of the road, extending from the centre of Crowsley Road for a
	distance of approx. 15.2 metres in a north-easterly direction and 14.7 metres
	in a southerly direction.
