

PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO INTRODUCE NEW PARKING RESTRICTIONS AT THE JUNCTION OF DUNCOMBE STREET AND STANLEY STREET, KEMPSTON

Reason for Proposals:

Bedford Borough Council has received a request from Ward Councillors for new parking restrictions at the junction of Duncombe Street with Howard Street, due to inconsiderate parking. The proposal is aimed at helping to maintain visibility and safety at this location.

Effect of the Order:

1. To introduce a double yellow line restriction (No waiting at any time) on the following lengths of roads:

Α	Stanley Street, Kempston
(i)	On both sides, extending from the southern side of Duncombe Street for a
	distance of approx. 5 metres in a southerly direction.
В	Duncombe Street, Kempston
(i)	On its southern side, extending from the western side of Stanley Street for a
	distance of approx. 5 metres in a westerly direction.
(ii)	On its southern side, extending from the eastern side of Stanley Street for a
	distance of approx. 5 metres in an easterly direction.
