

PUBLIC NOTICE

**BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO INTRODUCE A 20MPH ZONE
ON SOME ROADS IN ROXTON**

Reason for Proposal:

Planning conditions and a Section 38 agreement with Bedford Borough Council for the development by Mulberry Homes at Roxton required a 20mph zone, with associated traffic calming measures covering the roads on the new development.

Effect of the Order:

1. To introduce a 20mph zone covering the entire length of each of the following roads in Roxton:-

Elizabeth Drive	Platinum Way
Queens Gardens	Jubilee Road
