

PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO INTRODUCE NEW PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN GOODMAYES CLOSE, BEDFORD

Reason for Proposal:

Following a request from Ward Councillors, due to the narrowness of Goodmayes Close Bedford Borough Council proposes to introduce new parking restrictions to enable access by refuse vehicles (and potential emergency services), which currently experience difficulties due to vehicles parked on the carriageway.

Effect of the Proposal:

1. To introduce a 'No waiting at any time' restriction (double yellow lines) on the following length of road:-
