



PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO INTRODUCE PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN GREEN LANE, WIXAMS

Reason for Proposal:

Bedford Borough Council has received a request from the Parish Council for parking restrictions in Green Lane, opposite the junction of Nightingale Court to counter inconsiderate parking which is affecting visibility, movement of traffic and safety.

Effect of the Order:

- 1. To introduce 'No waiting at any time' restrictions (double yellow lines) on the following length of road:**

A	Green Lane, Wixams
(i)	On its western side, extending from the projected centre of Nightingale Court, in a north easterly direction, for a distance of approx. 47 metres.
(ii)	On its western side, extending from the projected centre of Nightingale Court, in a south westerly direction, for a distance of approx. 50 metres.

They will also be available for viewing on the council's website at www.bedford.gov.uk/proposedtro. The documents will be placed on deposit until 6 weeks after the Order is made or until it is decided not to continue with the proposal.
