



PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO INTRODUCE SOME PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN GREEN LANE, WIXAMS

Reason for Proposal:

Bedford Borough Council proposes to introduce “No stopping on entrance markings” restrictions in the vicinity of Wixams Academy and Wixams Tree Primary Academy. The restrictions are deemed necessary to maintain safety for both those attending the school and other highway users in the area.

Effect of the Order:

1. To introduce “No stopping on entrance markings” restrictions on the following length of road:

A	Green Lane, Wixams
(i)	On its north-western kerb, in 2 sections on both sides of the school entrance, extending from a point approx. 52 metres south-west of the projected centre of Thistle Lane to a point approx. 86 metres north-east of the projected centre of Thistle Lane.

They will also be available for viewing on the council's website at www.bedford.gov.uk/proposedtro. The documents will be placed on deposit until 6 weeks after the Order is made or until it is decided not to continue with the proposal.
