STATEMENT OF REASONS

Bedford Borough Council proposes to introduce "No stopping on entrance markings" restrictions in the vicinity of Wixams Academy and Wixams Tree Primary Academy. The restrictions are deemed necessary to maintain safety for both those attending the school and other highway users in the area.

This Order is proposed under the provisions of the **Traffic Management Act 2004** specifically Section 6, for the following reasons:

- 1. Avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road, or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
- 2. Facilitating the passage of traffic (including pedestrians) on the road or any other road.
- 3. Preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

Justification

- The restriction aims to improve safety for children and parents during school drop-off and pick-up times.
- Prevents vehicles from stopping on zig-zag markings, which obstruct visibility and create hazards for pedestrians crossing near the school entrance.
- Supports safe and efficient traffic flow in the vicinity of the school.
