



PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO INTRODUCE NEW PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN HIGH STREET, CLAPHAM

Reason for Proposal:

Bedford Borough Council intends to address parking issues in the vicinity of the garage in High Street, and rectify anomalies with the existing restrictions.

Effect of the Order:

- 1. To extend existing 'No waiting at any time' restrictions (double yellow lines) on the following length of road:**

A	High Street, Clapham
(i)	On its south-western kerb, extending from the projected north-western boundary of no. 85 (the end of the existing no waiting at any time restriction) for a distance of approx. 73 metres in a north-westerly direction.

The documents will be placed on deposit until 6 weeks after the Order is made or until it is decided not to continue with the proposal.
