

PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO INTRODUCE SOME PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN HIGH STREET, HARROLD

Reason for Proposal:

Bedford Borough Council has received a request from Harrold Parish Council for a new parking restriction in the High Street in front of The Oakley Arms public house. Existing parking causes visibility issues for vehicles in the High Street and Brook Lane. This restriction is deemed necessary to maintain safety for highway users in the area.

Effect of the Order:

1. To introduce 'No waiting at any time' restrictions (double primrose lines) on the following lengths of road:

Α	High Street, Harrold
(i)	On its north eastern kerb, extending from its junction with Orchard Lane in a
	south-easterly direction to a point in line with the projected boundary between
	no. 104 and The Oakley Arms public house.
