

Data Protection Privacy Statement – Household Waste Recycling Centre (HWRC) Permit Application

To deliver services to the citizens and communities in Bedford Borough, it is necessary for the Council to collect, gather, and process personal data about residents, staff, and other individuals. Bedford Borough Council is committed to protecting your personal data when you use its services and/or correspond with it.

The Council has registered as a Data Controller with the Information Commissioner's Office. This registration can be viewed on the [ICO website](#) (opens in a new window) Registration Number Z5916725.

As a Data Controller, the Council sets out the purposes and methods for processing information and ensures safeguards over any personal and special category information it processes.

The sections below explain what data we are collecting and storing and the arrangements we have in place to protect the information entrusted to the Council.

In relation to the HWRC Permit Application process, Bedford Borough Council will process your personal data for the following processing purposes:

To verify eligibility for a waste permit to be used at the Household waste recycling centre

The personal data that will be collected:

- Full name
- Residential address and postcode
- Email address
- Telephone number (if provided)
- Vehicle registration number
- Proof of address (e.g., council tax bill, utility bill, tenancy agreement)
- Proof of vehicle ownership (if required)
- Permit reference number and application history
- IP address and device information collected automatically when using the online form
- Site-access logs (e.g., ANPR)

Bedford Borough Council is processing this personal data by virtue of the following Lawful Basis:

Compliance with a legal obligation - Article 6(1)(c) - This lawful basis applies when the processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the data controller is subject.

Performance of a task carried out in the public interest - Article 6(1)(e) - This lawful basis applies when the processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the data controller.

Personal data provided for HWRC Permits may be shared with, the following organisations (in addition to any other disclosure required by a Court of Law or in response to a valid request by, normally, a law enforcement agency:

Pentagull a supplier who acts as a data processor on behalf of the Council, they do not use the data for their own purposes.

The processing of your personal data will be restricted in time to:

- **Permit application data** will be retained for **3 years** after the permit expires, to support service management, audit requirements, and fraud prevention.
- **Verification documents** (such as proof of address or proof of vehicle ownership) will be retained for **30–90 days** and deleted once eligibility checks are completed.
- **ANPR or site-access logs** (if used) will be retained for **up to 12 months**, unless required longer for an active investigation.
- **System audit logs** will be retained in line with the Council's corporate IT retention schedule, typically **1–2 years**.

Your personal data will be held by/for the Council within the UK

There are no additional uses of your personal data beyond the purposes stated above. Your information will only be used to verify eligibility, issue and manage HWRC permits, and support the operation and security of Bedford Borough Council's Household Waste Recycling Centres.

The processing of your information does **not** involve automated decision-making.

We have a range of measures to protect the personal data you provide. These include cyber security, physical security of the Council's buildings and training on Data Protection for staff.
