



PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO CHANGE SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR MARKINGS IN JOWITT AVENUE, KEMPSTON

Reason for Proposal:

Bedford Borough Council has received a request from Ward Councillors to change the School Keep Clear markings in Jowitt Avenue, Kempston.

Effect of the Order:

1. To revoke existing “No stopping on entrance markings, Mon – Fri, 8:00am – 4:30pm” restrictions on the following lengths of road:

A	Jowitt Avenue, Kempston
(i)	On its northern kerb, extending from the projected western boundary of property No.20 for a distance of approx. 37.5 metres in a westerly direction.
(ii)	On its northern (becoming north-western) kerb, extending from a point approx. 45 metres west of the projected western boundary of property No.20 for a distance of approx. 43.5 metres in a westerly direction.

2. To introduce “No stopping on entrance markings, Mon – Fri, 8:00am – 4:30pm” restrictions on the following length of road:

A	Jowett Avenue, Kempston
(i)	On its southern kerb, extending from a point approx. 5 metres east of the projected eastern boundary of property No.20 (the end of the existing ‘No waiting at any time’ restriction) for a distance of approx. 96 metres in a westerly direction.

3. To revoke the existing “No waiting at any time” restriction (double yellow lines) on the following length of road:

A	Jowett Avenue, Kempston
(i)	On its western kerb, extending from a point approx. 88.5 metres west of the projected western boundary of property No.20 for a distance of approx. 19 metres in a southerly direction.
