

PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO INTRODUCE NEW PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN KING STREET, KEMPSTON.

Reason for Proposal:

Bedford Borough Council has received a request for some new parking restrictions in King Street, Kempston. The proposal below is aimed at helping to maintain visibility along the road and to prevent the blocking of vehicular accesses.

Effect of the Order:

1. To introduce 'No waiting at any time' restrictions (double yellow lines) on the following length of road:

A	King Street, Kempston
(i)	On its western kerb, starting from the projected boundary between 2 and 2b King Street, Kempston for a distance of approx. 51 metres in a southerly direction.

They will also be available for viewing on the council's website at www.bedford.gov.uk/proposedtro. The documents will be placed on deposit until 6 weeks after the order is made or until it is decided not to continue with the proposal.
