

## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

### **BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO FORMALISE EXISTING WAITING RESTRICTIONS ON MANTON LANE AND INTRODUCE NEW WAITING RESTRICTIONS ON MURDOCK ROAD, BEDFORD**

#### **Reason for Proposal:**

Bedford Borough Council proposes to formalise waiting restrictions on Manton Lane and introduce waiting restrictions on Murdock Road to improve highway safety, maintain junction visibility, and ensure the free flow of traffic.

#### **Effect of the Order:**

- 1. To introduce ‘No waiting at any time’ restrictions on the following lengths of roads:**

<b>A</b>	<b>Manton Lane, Bedford</b>
	From the projected centre line of Murdock Road southwards for approximately 292 metres (in sections of 104 metres, 131 metres and 57 metres)
<b>B</b>	<b>Murdock Road, Bedford</b>
	On its north side starting approx. 5 metres east of the projected centre line of the junction with Manton Lane and extending eastwards for 28 metres.
