

PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO INTRODUCE 'ONE WAY TRAFFIC' RESTRICTIONS IN MONTGOMERY CLOSE, STEWARTBY

Reason for proposal: The requirement of a Planning and Section 278 Agreement with Bedford Borough Council stipulated that the north-western and south-eastern arms of Montgomery Close should be restricted to traffic flow in one direction only. The proposal allows cyclists to pedal contra-flow to vehicular traffic.

Effects of the order:

1. To introduce a 'one way traffic' restriction within the following lengths of road:

Street		From	То	Permitted direction of travel
1.	Montgomery Close western arm	Its junction with Stewartby Way	Its junction with Rousbury Road, Stewartby	South to North
2.	Montgomery Close eastern arm	Montgomery Close (north-east arm)	Its junction with Stewartby Way	North to South

2. To introduce a 'prohibition of entry' restriction within the following length of road:

Into		From	
1.	Montgomery Close western arm	Its junction with Rousbury Road, Stewartby	
2.	Montgomery Close eastern arm	Its junction with Stewartby Way	

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> The above restriction will not be applicable to pedal cycles, which are permitted to cycle contra-flow to the vehicular traffic
