



## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

### **PROPOSED ROAD TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES** **OLD FORD END ROAD, QUEENS PARK**

**Under Sections 90A TO 90I of the Highways Act 1980 Bedford Borough Council proposes to introduce traffic calming measures in Old Ford End Road and its connecting side roads, comprising a combination of road humps, speed cushions and raised junction tables.**

#### **Road Affected**

<b>Old Ford End Road</b>

Throughout its length between Martham Close and Chestnut Avenue at various points and at or near its junctions with adjoining roads.
--

The speed cushions will be approximately 75 mm high and 3.0 metres long by 1.6 metres wide. Flat-top road humps will include sections with plateaux of approximately 6 metres in length and will be constructed across the full width of the carriageway or in the form of paired speed cushions. Raised tables will be constructed at junctions to a similar height.
