

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (KEMPSTON) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2018 (AMENDMENT NO.16) ORDER 2022

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL ("the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended ("the Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as the "Bedford Borough Council (Kempston)
 (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places)
 (Consolidation) Order 2018 (Amendment No.16) Order 2022" and shall come
 into force on 4th July 2022.
- 2. As from the date upon which this Order comes into force the provisions of the Bedford Borough Council (Kempston) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2018 as amended shall be varied as follows:
 - (i) The plan schedule reference "Grid Ref: H 38 Revision No: 2" shall be deleted and the plan schedule reference "Grid Ref: H 38 Revision No: 3" shall be inserted.
- This Amendment shall be read and construed as one with the Bedford Borough Council (Kempston) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2018 as amended.



STATEMENT OF REASONS


Under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) Bedford Borough Council propose to establish a new zebra crossing in Orchard Street, Kempston. The proposal is intended to improve pedestrian safety in Orchard Street, as a zebra crossing will provide an identified, controlled crossing point for pedestrians.

To facilitate the carriageway lining associated with the new zebra crossing, it will be necessary to revoke some double yellow lines and a small section of single yellow line. The double and single yellow lines will be replaced by the requisite zebra crossing zig-zag lines.
