
# Ravensden

#### 2011 Census

Parish Profile

## October 2013






Located north of Bedford Town, Ravensden's population increased by 1,250 between 2001 and 2011 due to the development of Woodlands Park. Ravensden has a much younger age profile than the Borough, with 27% of residents aged 0-15, the highest of all parishes, and only 13% aged over 65. A broad mix of non-White British residents form 27% of the population, the second highest of all parishes, and 13% of all households are lone parents with dependent children.

Ravensden has high home ownership (74%), with 19% of households renting from social landlords and 7% renting privately. Housing is primarily detached (50%) with large numbers of semi-detached (22%) and terraced (16%) homes. Two-thirds of homes are heated by gas, and 20% by oil.

Employment as managers, directors and in professional occupations (38%) exceeds the rural parish average. Self employment (10%) and employment in skilled trades (11%) match Borough averages. The proportion of residents aged 16+ with degree-level qualifications (34%) exceeds the Borough average, and only 15% have no qualifications. Health levels are better than the Borough, partly due to Ravensden's younger age profile.

Only 7% of households do not have a car, 41% have 2 cars, and 13% have 3 or more. Most people travel to work by car (79%), 7% work from home, 6% commute by train, and only 4% cycle or walk to work.
