



Located in the north of Bedford Borough, Riseley has a similar age profile to the Borough with 19% of residents aged 0-15 and 19% aged over 65. Riseley has a lower proportion aged 20-39 than the Borough, and the non-White British population (4%) is among the lowest of all parishes.

The proportion of one-person households (21%), evenly divided between pensioners and non-pensioners, is below the average for rural parishes. Riseley has high home ownership (79%), with 13% of households renting from social landlords and 8% renting privately. A majority of housing is detached (58%), and 82% of homes are heated by gas.


Self-employment (14%) and employment in skilled trades (14%) are both high, and employment as managers, directors and in professional occupations (35%) matches the average for all parishes.

The proportion of residents aged 16+ with degree-level qualifications (36%) exceeds the average for rural parishes, and 16% of residents have no qualifications.

Only 7% of households do not have a car, 48% have 2 cars, and 14% have 3 or more. Most people travel to work by car (75%), 10% work from home, and 4% commute by train, but 11% of those in employment cycle or walk to work, which is the second highest of all rural parishes.
