BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO EXTEND THE WAITING RESTRICTIONS IN RUSHDEN ROAD, WYMINGTON

Reason for Proposal:

Bedford Borough Council proposes to extend the waiting restrictions in Rushden Road, Wymington. The restrictions are deemed necessary to ensure access for refuse and emergency vehicles into the new development.

Effect of the Order:

1. To extend the 'No waiting at any time' restrictions on the following length of road:

A	Rushden Road, Wymington
(i)	On its western kerb, from the boundary of Nos 115 and 113 for a length of 13.7 metres up to the existing waiting restrictions
