ROAD TRAFFIC CALMING, PROPOSED HUMPS **SILVER STREET, GREAT BARFORD**

Notice is hereby given that Bedford Borough Council, in exercise of its powers under sections 90A to 90C of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to construct road humps in the road specified below, in accordance with the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999

Road Affected

Silver Street, Great Barford

The proposals are to construct five round-top road humps, each approximately 3.7 metres in length as part of a traffic calming scheme associated with the proposed 20mph speed zone on Silver Street, Great Barford

Each road hump will:

- Be of round-top profile
- Have a maximum height not exceeding 75 millimetres
- Extend across the width of the carriageway
- Be constructed in accordance with the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999

The exact locations of the proposed road humps are shown on drawing:
