BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO EXTEND THE EXISTING 40MPH SPEED LIMIT ON SILVER STREET IN STEVINGTON

Reason for Proposal:

Following a request from Stevington Parish Council, Bedford Borough Council proposes to extend the 40mph speed limit in Silver Street.

Effect of the Order:

1. To extend the 40mph speed limit on the following length of road:-

A	Silver Street, Stevington
(i)	Extending from a point approx. 400 metres southwest of the westernmost boundary of number 57 Silver Street (the end of the existing 40mph speed limit) for a distance of approx. 134 metres in a southerly direction.

They will also be available for viewing on the council's website at www.bedford.gov.uk/proposedtro. The documents will be placed on deposit until 6 weeks after the Order is made or until it is decided not to continue with the proposal.
