**BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (RAVESNDEN: PART OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH
No. 25)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2025**

The above Order made on 18 September 2025 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 will divert:-

- i. That length of Public Footpath numbered 25 in the Parish of Ravensden in the environs of "Tycroes Farm," Ravensden commencing from a point where it has a junction with the unaffected part of Footpath 25 approximately 143 metres south-west of the residential property known as "Old Farm Cottage" Ravensden at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 0702/5386 shown as Point A on the Order Map and running in a north east direction for approximately 152 metres to OSGR TL 0711/5398 shown as Point B on the Order Map to a point commencing from a point where it has a junction with the unaffected part of Footpath 25 approximately 143 metres south-west of the residential property known as "Old Farm Cottage" Ravensden at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 0702/5386 shown as Point A on the Order Map then running in a generally north- east direction for approximately 114 metres and then north for approximately 14 metres and then north-east for approximately 26 metres where it connects to the public road known as Old Ways Home shown as Point C on the Order Map at OSGR TL 0710/5399.

If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
