

PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO INTRODUCE A 20MPH SPEED LIMIT AT ST MARYS STREET, BEDFORD

Reason for Proposal:

Following a request from Ward Councillors, Bedford Borough Council proposes to reduce the speed limit to 20mph in the part of St Marys Street adjoining High Street, Bedford. This will in effect extend the existing 20mph speed limit covering High Street, St Paul's Square and the adjoining area.

Effect of the Order:

1. To introduce a 20mph speed limit on the following length of road in Bedford:

Α	St Marys Street, Bedford
(i)	Extending from its junction with High Street / St Paul's Square in a southerly
	direction to its junction with Duck Mill Lane.

They will also be available for viewing on the council's website at www.bedford.gov.uk/proposedtro. The documents will be placed on deposit until 6 weeks after the Order is made or until it is decided not to continue with the proposal.
