ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 23

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO ESTABLISH 3 NEW ZEBRA CROSSINGS AT ST PAUL'S SQUARE AND THE EMBANKMENT, BEDFORD

Reason for Proposal: As part of the Town Deal highway improvement works at St Paul's Square, Bedford Borough Council propose to install 3 zebra crossings.

The Location of the Proposed Zebra Crossings

Two of the zebra crossings are in St Paul's Square, Bedford.

One of them is located in the northern leg of St Paul's Square, outside property no. 8 (known as Sharmans Solicitors), the centre of the crossing approximately 3.5 metres east of the western flank wall of no.8;

the other is located in the western leg, the centre of the crossing approximately 9.5 metres south of the southern side of Horne Lane.

The third zebra crossing is located in The Embankment, the centre of the crossing is approximately 11 metres east of the eastern side of St Marys Street.

Further Details of the proposed zebra crossings, a plan and a statement of reasons for proposing to establish the crossings may be examined during normal working hours at Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford. These documents are also available on the www.bedford.gov.uk/tro website. The details will be placed on deposit until 6 weeks after the crossings are commissioned or until it is decided not to continue with the proposal.
