BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO FORMALISE EXISTING WAITING RESTRICTIONS ON STAGSDEN ROAD, BROMHAM

Reason for Proposal:

Bedford Borough Council proposes to formalise existing waiting restrictions on Stagsden Road, Bromham. The restrictions are deemed necessary to address inconsiderate parking and improve visibility and road safety in the vicinity.

Effect of the Order:

- 1. Lengths of road upon which 'No waiting at any time' restrictions shall apply:**

A	Stagsden Road, Bromham
(i)	On its northern kerb, extending from a point approx. 6.6 metres east of the projected centre of Quenby Way for a distance of 66 metres in an easterly direction.

They will also be available for viewing on the council's website at www.bedford.gov.uk/proposedtro. The documents will be placed on deposit until 6 weeks after the Order is made or until it is decided not to continue with the proposal.
