

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO INTRODUCE SOME PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN STATION ROAD, WILLINGTON

Reason for Proposal:

Bedford Borough Council has received a request from Willington Parish Council to introduce some waiting restrictions in Station Road, Willington. This is in response to safety concerns being raised over vehicles parking close to the junctions of Warren Farm and Gostwick Place

Parking at this location can cause access, egress and visibility issues, particularly so for emergency service vehicles, so this proposal is intended to address those issues.

Effect of the Order:

1. To introduce 'No waiting at any time' restrictions on the following lengths of road:

A	Warren Farm, Willington
(i)	Southern kerb line: From a point approximately 8.5 metres west of the centreline of the access road serving Warren Farm at its junction with Station Road, extending south-westwards for a distance of approximately 16 metres.
(ii)	Northern kerb line: From a point approximately 8.5 metres west of the centreline of the access road serving Warren Farm at its junction with Station Road, extending north-westwards for a distance of approximately 20.8 metres.
B	Gostwick Place, Willington
(i)	Southern kerb line: From a point approximately 10.5 metres east of the centreline of Gostwick Place at its junction with Station Road, extending south-eastwards for a distance of approximately 50 metres.
(ii)	Northern kerb line: From a point approximately 10.5 metres east of the centreline of Gostwick Place at its junction with Station Road, extending north-eastwards for a distance of approximately 20.8 metres.
