BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO INTRODUCE A BUSES ONLY RIGHT TURN FROM GREYFRIARS ONTO BROMHAM ROAD, BEDFORD

Reason for Proposal:

As part of the Town Deal highway improvement works at Greyfriars, Bedford Borough Council intends to allow buses only to make a right turn onto Bromham Road from Greyfriars. All other vehicles will be prohibited from making a right turn.

Effect of the Order:

- 1. To introduce a Prohibition of Right Turn, except buses, from Greyfriars onto Bromham Road, Bedford.**

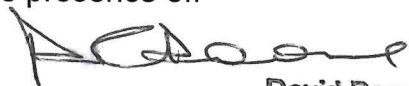
**BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (BROMHAM ROAD, BEDFORD)
(PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURNS EXCEPT BUSES) ORDER 2025**

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("The Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. No person except buses or except upon the direction or with permission of a Police Constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to make a right turn into Bromham Road at its junction with Greyfriars.
2. In this order "bus" means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted to carry more than eight passengers (exclusive of the driver) and used for the carriage of passengers for hire or reward.
3. Nothing in Article 1 shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire brigade or Special Forces purposes in the event of an emergency.
4. This Order shall come into operation on 27th October 2025 and may be cited as the "Bedford Borough Council (Bromham Road, Bedford) (Prohibition of Right Turns except buses) Order 2025".

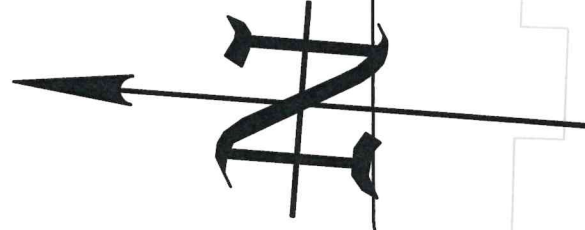
