

PUBLIC NOTICE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 23

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO ESTABLISH A TOUCAN CROSSING ON GREYFRIARS, BEDFORD

<u>Reason for Proposal:</u> As part of the Town Deal highway improvement works at Greyfriars, Bedford Borough Council intends to install a new signalled crossing.

<u>The Location of the Proposed Toucan Crossing</u> is on Greyfriars, Bedford. The centre of the crossing will be approximately 68 metres east of the projected centre of Alexandra Place, Bedford.

<u>Further Details</u> of the proposed toucan crossing, a plan and a statement of reasons for proposing to establish the crossing may be examined during normal working hours at Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford. These documents are also available on the www.bedford.gov.uk/tro website. The details will be placed on deposit until 6 weeks after the crossings are commissioned or until it is decided not to continue with the proposal.
