BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO INTRODUCE A 20MPH SPEED LIMIT ON SOME ROADS IN COTTON END

Reason for Proposal:

Cotton End Parish Council have requested that the speed limit be reduced to 20mph on Wood Lane and adjoining roads in the Parish, following complaints from residents about speeding through the village.

The proposed 20mph speed limits are intended to provide a safer road network for all highway users, including motor cyclists, pedal cyclists and pedestrians.

Effect of the Order:

- To introduce a 20mph speed limit covering the entire length of each of the following roads in Cotton End:-**

Wood Lane	Manor Way
Hall Way	The Crescent
Meeting Close	Bunkers Drive
Gales Place
